The major vision envisaged for the Institute is to provide the best quality and incomparable education in Unani Medicine leading to Graduate, Post-Graduate and Doctoral Degree levels, Diploma Course in AYUSH-Nursing & Pharmacy, various Short-Term Courses in Ilaj Bit Tadbeer (Hijamah), Tazeeniayt (Cosmetology), Gizaiyaat (Dietetics) Long-Term and Short-Term Courses for Foreign Medical and Non-Medical Professionals, Teaching and Training in various fields of Unani, providing the best Treatment facilities including Specialized Treatments to the general public under no profit and no loss basis, undertaking Scientific Research in various aspects of Unani, helping and contributing for Globalization of Unani and upgrading the Institute to the level of an Institution of National Importance and Centre of Excellence and to attain a Deemed to be University Status.

- Free distribution of Unani drugs among OPD and IPD patients.
- Free registration and 50% rebate on investigations to the patients belonging to BPL, SC, ST and senior citizens.
- Dedicated pharmacy for the preparation of Unani drugs as per pharmacopeia for free distribution in the hospital.
- Diagnostic facility such as laboratory tests, ultrasonography, X-ray, ECG, 2D echo, etc at subsided rates. Collaboration with other laboratories to carry out diagnostic facilities not available in NIUM in subsided rates.
- Providing Health prevention and promotion of Unani education among general public.
- Providing Unani treatment to Tribal's inhabited at Karnataka by way of medical camps.
- Active participation in Arogya Melas, Exhibitions, etc.
- Conducting National and International Seminars/Conferences/CME/Training programmes in Unani Medicine.
- Conducting free medical health check-ups.
- Observation of National and International programmes for public awareness.
- Adoption of schools for health appraisal.



### **Vision Document**

The Vision Document keeping in view various strategies and goals set out for the Institute comprises of the educational, training programs, patient care, Research, etc shall be framed in the following manner for the proposed 7 Years Strategy from 2020-2021 to 2027-2028.

The main objectives and functions of the Institute is to produce Graduates, Post-Graduates and Post-Doctoral Level Courses including a Diploma Course and Short-Term Training Courses in Unani. The Institute is likely to import Short-Term Courses on basics and fundamentals of Unani Medicine for foreign medical and para-medical personnel interested to know and study about Unani Medicine and also to help introduce and develop Unani Medicine in the health care needs of their countries.

For this, the Institute provides sufficient seats in its Post-Graduate and Post-Doctoral Courses for foreign nationals of any country.

Presently, the Institute is giving admission in PG Unani for 57 students and Subject to the availability of Guide, Maximum sealing of 6 scholars at time in the two departments at Doctoral Level annually. The bed capacity of the hospital is 180. After establishing all the 14 departments in PG Unani the intake of the students increases to 106, for PhD it will be upto 48 and the strength of bed would be around 250. The Institute is having an established well maintained Central Laboratory to cater the needs of patients/hospital.

The main research activity is limited to PG and PhD students, though teachers of the Institute are also involved in Short-Term Research activities. The Institute has also facilities for undertaking any research project from outside agencies interested in clinical trials.

In the coming years, the Institute proposes to enhance and enrich its infrastructure facilities like enhancing Hospital space enhancing patient facilities enriching the Laboratories, Museums, etc. Further developing the Drug Standardization and Research Laboratory, Upgrading the existing Pharmacy manufacturing medicines to meet the maximum needs of IPD and OPD patients, Upgrading the Ilaj bit Tadbeer Unit to provide high class Ilaj bit Tadbeer and Jild Therapies not only to domestic patients but to foreigners also who are keenly interested to undergo Ilaj bit Tadbeer which is gaining international attention to keep a sound and disease-free life.

The Institute will also focus on strategies to provide consultation, expertise and advice to the general public for maintaining sound and disease-free life in order to keep away from life style disorders and to get rid of various ageing related disorders.

Keeping in view these goals and strategies, the Institute proposes the following 15 Year Strategy and the 5 Year Action Plan and Implementation Document.
