Instructions for the trainees of CME Programme

- All transaction will be made only by electronic transfers through banks.
- No amount will be paid to trainees except the reimbursement of travelling expenses, that too on actual basis as per rules subject to ceiling.
- The payment will be made as per CME guidelines or rate of tickets, whichever is less.
- Road mileage is allowed only for places not connected by rail, with regards to road mileage actual fare but not exceeding approved rate under TA rules, claimant should mentioned the distance between the places.
- Places which are connected by rail, the road mileage is limited to 2 AC rail charges or actual claim, whichever is less.
- Local trainees may be paid Rs. 500/- per programme towards local TA only once for to and fro.
- Persons are eligible for food expenses if travel made by train/ bus on production of bills subject to a maximum of Rs. 175/- during the journey. No food expenses are paid for travel made by Rajdhani / Shatabdi / Duranto trains and air tickets.
- Boarding and Lodging will be provided by the organizers of the CME. No separate DA will be paid
- Individual accommodation and boarding expenses will not be entertained for reimbursement.

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
